

Free Project Sheet

Quick and Easy Fleece Throws

Supplies:

- Sharp fabric scissors, Pinking Shears or Rotary Cutter, Mat and Ruler
- Quilting or Safety Pins
- Masking Tape
- 2 Coordinating Fleece Prints and/or solids (great for sporting your BSU colors)

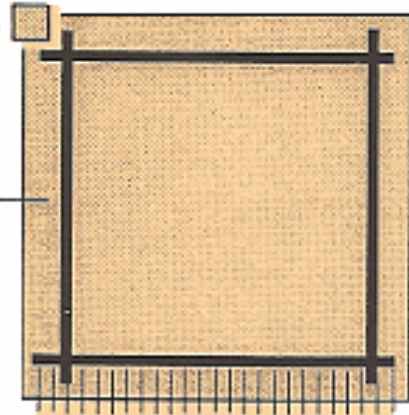
58" Blanket: 1 2/3 yard each

14" Pillow: 5/8 yard each

36" Baby Blanket: 1 1/4" yard each

remove 4"
square from
corners

masking tape



cut fringe at 1" intervals

Instructions:

1. Lay one piece of fabric on your work surface with the **WRONG** side up with selvages on the left and right. Lay the second piece of fabric **RIGHT** side up on top of the first, with the selvages on the top and bottom. This will stabilize your blanket.
2. Remove selvages and trim fabric to a 58" square. Use a few pins to hold the pieces together.
3. Place masking tape on all sides of the top piece of fleece, four inches from the edge. Cut fringe at one inch intervals, using the masking tape as a guide. You may use scissors, pinking shears, or your rotary cutter and mat.
4. Tie the top and bottom layers in a knot at each fringe. At the corners, cross over the fringe so the bottom right connects to the top left, etc.

For Pillow: Cut fleece into 22" squares. Cut fringe 3 inches. Tie three sides, slip pillow inside and tie remaining edge.

For Baby Blanket: Cut fleece into 36" squares. Cut fringe 3 inches.
